Lean Skills

Design and build a real manufacturing cell

Once you have started on your lean journey, the lean techniques of cellular flow, 5-S and visual factory are critical building blocks for your lean enterprise. Your knowledge of these tools and the ability to apply them properly will be enhanced by your attendance at this intensive day-long session. In the morning we will go through a detailed training session on how to design, balance and build a one-piece flow work cell. The



materials that will be provided in this session will be invaluable to you when you return to your own company. The afternoon will include the actual building of a "living cell" where we will make a real product. As we build the cell, we will incorporate the companion techniques of 5-S, visual factory, pull systems, and performance measures. All participants will receive a CD containing all of the analytical tools demonstrated in the workshop. Participants in this track will have the option of transferring to the Lean Fundamentals track in the afternoon.
